AN ORDINANCE

appropriating funds for the construction of speed humps on Trinity Place; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Trinity Place and Allen Street Project Revenue Account No. 440-8800-480.10-00, C00549 to the Trinity Place and Allen Street Project Account No. 440-8800-881.49-90, C00549 for the construction of speed humps on Trinity Place.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



Re: Appropriating Funds to the Trinity Place and Allen Street Project

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance appropriating funds to the Trinity Place and Allen Street project for the construction of speed humps.

DISCUSSION:

At the February 18, 2013 Council meeting, staff presented a report concerning a request received from the Columbia Housing Authority (CHA) to modify the existing one-way street network along Trinity Place and Allen Street. Public Works staff had recommended, and the City Manager approved, a temporary traffic regulation that allowed two-way traffic along Trinity Place, from Pendleton Street to Switzler Street. CHA requested to make this a permanent change, as well as change Allen Street to two-way traffic, from Lasalle Place to Trinity Place. Ordinance 21656 was passed on April 15, 2013 authorizing these changes.

In addition, CHA requested two traffic calming speed humps along Trinity Place, and a modification to the intersection of Trinity Place and Park Avenue. Staff reported that the addition of speed humps along Trinity Place would help to encourage lower speeds, and should therefore increase the overall pedestrian safety in the area, as well as for those using the recently constructed pedestrian signal at Providence. CHA agreed to fund the costs associated with the construction of the speed humps, and City forces would perform the work. Construction of the speed humps is scheduled for mid-October 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$10,000 from CHA is being appropriated to the Trinity Place and Allen Street project account for the construction of speed humps on Trinity Place by city forces.
