**AN ORDINANCE**

calling the Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, to elect Council Members for Wards 1 and 5 for the City of Columbia; directing notification of the election authority; describing the form of ballot, and the form of notice of election; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, the general municipal election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of Columbia, Missouri, on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, to elect the following municipal officers:

Council Member, First Ward  
Council Member, Fifth Ward

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Clerk of the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri, of the adoption of this ordinance no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 28, 2014, and to include in the notification all of the terms and provisions required by Chapter 115, RSMo. as amended.

SECTION 3. The form of the Notice of Election shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. The City Clerk is directed to complete the Notice of Election by inserting the names of the candidates for each office in the order of the date their nominating petitions, sufficiently signed and attested, were filed with the Clerk.

SECTION 4. The election shall be held and conducted, and the results thereof canvassed and returned, in all respects in accordance with the laws of the State of Missouri and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

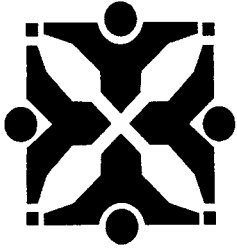

Re: April Municipal Election

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

A council bill has been prepared to call the municipal election for April 8, 2014.

**DISCUSSION:**

Under the City Charter, a regular election for municipal officials is held every April. In April 2014, the election will be for council members for Wards 1 and 5. Each candidate for the Wards 1 and 5 positions must file a nominating petition signed by at least 50 but no more than 75 registered voters entitled to vote for the candidate. Nominating petitions must be filed no later than January 14, 2014.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Fiscal impact unknown at this time. The cost is based on the various entities who have placed an item on the ballot for any particular election. The City's proportionate share for the April 2013 election was \$58,649.60, which was a City-wide election to fill the positions of Mayor and Wards 3 and 4.

The City's proportionate share of the April 2012 election was \$11,254.93, which was an election to fill the positions of Wards 2 and 6.
