Dr. Martin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The draft *open* meeting minutes of the December 11, 2013 regular meeting were distributed in advance of the meeting and were approved. The draft *closed* meeting minutes of the December 11, 2013 regular meeting were distributed in advance of the meeting and were approved.

Mr. Sheltmire recognized that a compliment was submitted regarding Officer Whitmire.

Mr. Sheltmire has been checking brochure locations and other members will check various places as well. Mr. Sheltmire said that they need to follow up for future new recruit training with the CPD.

Ms. Wilson said there is nothing to report at this time from the Mediation Task Force.

Mr. Sheltmire made a motion for the Police Chief to provide a written report to the Board's proposed ordinance changes no later than one (1) week prior to the next meeting. Motion seconded by Ms. Wilson. Dr. Alexander, Mr. Dean, Mr. Dowis, Mr. Fisher, Dr. Kennett, Dr. Martin, Mr. Sheltmire, and Ms. Wilson voted in favor of the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Ms. Wibbenmeyer has been working on the 2013 Annual Report. The Board discussed the draft reports they received.

The Board discussed the monthly external complaint tally reports they receive from the Columbia Police Department. The Board would like to see the raw data involved with the complaints rather than just a tally that has been given in the report. The proposed ordinance changes include the Board also receiving a copy of the actual complaint.

The Board discussed their bylaws. Any suggestions for changes will be submitted to Ms. Wibbenmeyer.

The Board reviewed CPRB case CPRB 2013-0007 filed by Mr. Gibbs. Dr. Kennett made a motion to uphold the Chief's decision and that a letter is drafted to be edited by the Chair in regard to this complaint. Ms. Wilson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Scott Dean that the Chair writes a letter to Chief Burton recommending training on policies concerning citation signatures. Mr. Sheltmire seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Lt. Buck gave a presentation to the Board on mental health issues and the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT).
