

A RESOLUTION

declaring the necessity for the replacement and upgrade of a water main along Hinkson Avenue, between Old Highway 63 and William Street; stating the nature of and the estimated cost of the project; providing for payment for the improvement; determining that the work shall be done by City employees; and setting a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council deems the replacement of a 4-inch cast iron water main with an 8-inch PVC water main along Hinkson Avenue, between Old Highway 63 and William Street, in accordance with Water and Light Department water main plans and specifications, is necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 2. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$300,000.00.

SECTION 3. Payment for this improvement shall be made from the Water and Electric Fund using funds appropriated in Capital Improvement Project No. WT0239.

SECTION 4. The above described work shall not be bid but shall be constructed by city employees as advised by the City Manager.

SECTION 5. A public hearing in respect to this improvement will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on May 5, 2014. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

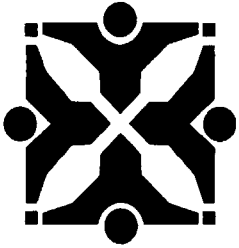

Re: Public Hearing - Hinkson Avenue Water Main Replacement

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution setting a public hearing for May 5, 2014 concerning the replacement and upgrade of a 4-inch cast iron water main along Hinkson Avenue from Old Highway 63 to Williams Street. The estimated cost for this improvement is \$300,000 and funding for this project has been appropriated in project WT0239 of the Capital Improvement Program. Staff conducted an interested parties meeting for this project on April 9, 2014.

DISCUSSION:

The Columbia Water and Light Department has identified the need to replace aging water distribution infrastructure on Hinkson Avenue from Old Highway 63 to Williams Street in conjunction with Public Works 2014 street mill and overlay program. This project will replace an existing 4-inch cast iron main that has a poor maintenance history with a new 8-inch PVC main. Construction of this water main will increase water flows to the area for consumer and fire protection needs as well as increase the maintainability and dependability of the area's water distribution infrastructure. The current design proposal for this project is to locate the new 8-inch water main in street right of way approximately 3-feet in front of the face of curb beneath the street pavement. This improvement is intended to precede plans by the Public Works to overlay the Hinkson Avenue this summer.

Upon City Council approval for this water main replacement project, final plans will be completed and issued to city forces for construction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding of \$300,000 for this project has been transferred from project WT0130 for annual main replacements to project number WT0239, Hinkson Main Replacement, of the current Capital Improvement Program.
