**AN ORDINANCE**

authorizing a program order to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for work zone enforcement activities; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a program order to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for work zone enforcement activities for the period of July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2014. The form and content of the program order shall be substantially in the same form as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto. Any actions taken by or on behalf of the City in connection with such STIP agreement prior to the date of this ordinance are hereby approved and ratified.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Federal Revenues Account No. 110-2120-461.10-00 G-STIP to the Salaries/Overtime Account No. 110-2154-511.01-41 G-STIP.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



Re: MO Department of Transportation - Work Zone Enforcement Grant

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of Program Order #DWZEA15Z, and appropriating funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the Missouri Department of Transportation for Work Zone Enforcement.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission has authorized funds to support the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) On Call Work Zone Enforcement activities. These funds are provided to fund overtime for law enforcement operations for work zone enforcement activities to further STIP On Call Work Zone Enforcement.

This Program Order #DWZEA15Z is in conjunction with the Program Agreement already on file (Ordinance #021678), that runs from October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2017. The new Program Order #DWZEA15Z funding runs from July 1, 2013 through December 31, 2014.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The Work Zone Enforcement Agreement provides reimbursement for police overtime pay related to enforcement activities. No matching funds are required.


