### **AN ORDINANCE**

amending Chapter 12 of the City Code to prohibit certain discrimination based on gender identity; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 12-18. Functions, powers and duties.

The commission shall have the following functions, powers and duties:

(1) To formulate and carry out educational programs designed to minimize or eliminate those discriminatory practices made unlawful by Article III of this chapter.

. . .

(6) To encourage fair treatment for all persons regardless of age as it relates to employment, race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, marital status, handicap, sexual orientation, gender identity or familial status as it relates to housing.

Sec. 12-32. Definitions.

For the purposes of this article, the following words and terms shall have the meanings respectively ascribed:

. . .

Family. This word includes a single individual.

<u>Gender identity</u>. The gender-related identity, appearance, or mannerisms or other gender-related characteristics of an individual, with or without regard to the individual's designated sex at birth.

Handicap. A physical or mental impairment resulting in a disability unrelated to a person's ability to perform the duties of a particular job or position for which otherwise the person would be eligible and qualified for employment or promotions; to utilize the existing public accommodations; to acquire, rent or maintain property; to enter into a loan or other financial transaction for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, improving, repairing or maintaining real property; or to participate as a member in those organizations or facilities specified in section 12-41(1)—(3) of this article.

*Protected category.* Race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, marital status, handicap, or sexual orientation or gender identity.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

RE: Amendment to the Human Rights Ordinance to Prohibit Discrimination Based on Gender Identity

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

At the request of the Mayor, a council bill has been drafted that would amend the City's Human Rights ordinance to prohibit discrimination based on gender identity.

### **DISCUSSION:**

PROMO, a Missouri statewide organization advocating for lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender equality, has requested that Columbia's nondiscrimination ordinance be updated to prohibit discrimination based on gender identity.

A bill has been drafted that would add a definition of "gender identity" to Chapter 12 of the City Code and include gender identity in the definition of "protected category."

"Gender identity" would be defined as, "The gender-related identity, appearance, or mannerisms or other gender-related characteristics of an individual, with or without regard to the individual's designated sex at birth."

The proposed amendments would prohibit discrimination against transgendered individuals in housing, employment and public accommodations.

# **VISION IMPACT:**

This amendment is consistent with the Vision Statement indicating that Columbia's future is one where we embrace and help create a welcoming, just, responsive, proactive, understanding, and respectful environment for residents and visitors alike – celebrating, rather than denigrating our collective diversity.

# SUGGESTED COUNCIL ACTION:

Passage of the ordinance if the council wishes to prohibit discrimination based on gender identity.
