AN ORDINANCE

determining it is in the public interest to construct the Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2 project on the north side of Worley Street between Bernadette Drive and Clinkscales Road; approving and adopting plans and specifications; determining that the work shall be done by contract; calling for bids through the Purchasing Division; providing for payment for the improvement; authorizing the City Manager to obtain, execute and record all documents necessary for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law and state-mandated construction safety training; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the necessity of constructing the Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2 project on the north side of Worley Street between Bernadette Drive and Clinkscales Road; and

WHEREAS, the notice of a public hearing on this project was published in a daily newspaper of general circulation in the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing on construction of the improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that the construction of a five-foot wide sidewalk on the north side of Worley Street between Bernadette Drive and Clinkscales Road, storm drain inlets and pipes, the reconstruction of two crosswalks and nine driveways to meet ADA requirements, and other miscellaneous work, all in accordance with City of Columbia Street and Storm Sewer Specifications and Standards, in the City of Columbia, Missouri, more specifically described as the Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2 project, is necessary for the welfare and improvement of the city and that it is in the public interest that such improvements be made. SECTION 2. The plans and specifications for this improvement, as prepared by the Director of Public Works, are hereby approved and made a part of this ordinance by reference.

SECTION 3. The construction of the improvement shall be done by contract in accordance with the plans and specifications, the laws of the State of Missouri, and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri.

SECTION 4. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to call for bids and execute a contract for the improvement.

SECTION 5. Payment for this improvement shall be made from Community Development Block Grant Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. The City Manager is authorized to obtain, execute and have recorded all licenses, easements, deeds and any other conveyances or instruments necessary for the City to complete this improvement.

SECTION 7. The contract for the improvement shall provide that not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as found by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of Missouri, shall be paid to all workers performing work under the contract. The contractor's bond shall guarantee the faithful performance of the prevailing hourly wage clause in the contract. The City shall also cause to be inserted into the contract a stipulation that all laborers and mechanics employed by the contractor or subcontractors in the performance of work under the contract shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on similar construction in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act.

SECTION 8. The bid specifications and contract for the improvement shall provide that the contractor and any subcontractor shall provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration construction safety program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations) for all employees working on-site. All employees working on the site of the improvement are required to complete the safety program within 60 days of beginning work on the improvement project.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



Re: Easement Acquisition and Bid Call - Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration two ordinances; one authorizing the acquisition of necessary easements, and the other calling for bids through the Purchasing division for the construction of the Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2 project. The project includes a sidewalk along the north side of Worley Street from Bernadette Drive to Clinkscales Road, as shown on the attached location map. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) requires construction of this project be completed by September 2014. A public hearing was held at the April 1, 2013 City Council meeting.

DISCUSSION:

One (1) permanent sidewalk easement, one (1) permanent street easement, three (3) permanent drainage easements, and eleven (11) temporary construction easements are needed from ten (10) separate property owners for the construction of the Worley Street Sidewalk Phase 2 project, from Bernadette Drive to Clinkscales Road. Staff has contacted property owners, from whom easements are required, informing them of this ordinance. Right of Way plans showing the proposed easements are attached, as well as plan and profile sheets, and a Property Owner Contact Log.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The project is estimated to cost \$194,500 and will be funded from a CDBG grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. In FY 2012, \$40,000 was budgeted and an additional \$154,500 is budgeted in FY 2014.


