Members of the public were present.

The regular monthly meeting of the Citizens Police Review Board was held on Wednesday, April 10, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber. Dr. Martin, Chair, opened the meeting at 7:01 p.m.

The draft minutes of the March 13, 2013 regular meeting were distributed in advance of the meeting and were approved.

There were no Positive Connections to report.

Mr. Sheltmire stated as part of the Outreach Committee, he would keep track of the distribution of the Board's brochures to various locations around town. Dr. Alexander reported that he gave a presentation about the Board to staff of Biological Sciences at MU and plans to give a presentation in May to about 150 people in MU Arts and Sciences.

The Mediation Task Force had no activity to report.

The Policy and Procedure Subcommittee had nothing to report at this time.

The Board performed a full review of Marlon Jordan's appeal, CPRB 2012-0008. Officer Cyndi McLane and Daryl Jordan were invited as witnesses by the Board and were not present. Marlon Jordan was present and spoke to the Board.

Mr. Dowis moved that the Board proceed with a vote on CPRB 2012-0008 based on the record presented. Dr. Alexander seconded that motion. The motion carried with Dr.

Alexander, Mr. Dean, Mr. Dowis, Mr. Hargrove and Mr. Sheltmire voting in favor of the motion; Mr. Jacob and Ms. Wilson were opposed to the motion.

Mr. Dowis moved that the Board uphold the decision of Chief Burton in CPRB 2012-0008 in that the complaint was unfounded. Mr. Hargrove seconded that motion. The motion carried with Dr. Alexander, Mr. Dean, Mr. Dowis, Mr. Hargrove and Mr. Sheltmire voting in favor of the motion; Mr. Jacob and Ms. Wilson were opposed to the motion.

The Board conducted an initial review of a case filed by Marlon Jordan, CPRB 2013-0002. Mr. Hargrove moved that this item is not before the Board at this time. Mr. Dowis seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Board conducted an initial review of a case filed by Matthew Akins, CPRB 2013-0001. Mr. Akins appeared and spoke before the Board. Mr. Sheltmire moved that this is not subject to the Board's review. Mr. Hargrove seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Jacob moved to invite Chief Burton to come to the Board's May 8, 2013 meeting. Dr. Alexander seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Board discussed the Citizens Police Review Board Supplement to the 2012 Annual Report and the reports provided by the Columbia Police Department Internal Affairs Unit.

Mr. Jacob moved to invite Lieutenant Shelley Jones to come to the Board's May 8, 2013 meeting. Dr. Martin seconded. No vote was taken. Mr. Jacob and Mr. Hargrove volunteered to perform an audit of the numbers and information provided by the Internal Affairs report included in the Citizens Police Review Board Supplement to the 2012 Annual Report.

The Board discussed the Citizens Police Review Board Fiscal Year 2014 budget. Ms. Wilson moved that the Board request an additional \$15,000 be added to their miscellaneous contractual portion of the Board's budget for the purposes of funding the Mediation Program Coordinator for the Fiscal Year 2014 budget. Dr. Alexander seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Board decided to send two members to the annual NACOLE conference.

A member of the public commented.

Mr. Jacob made a motion to dissolve the Policy and Procedure Subcommittee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hargrove and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Sheltmire moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hargrove, and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
