Re: Proposed Parking Prohibition on Rainbow Trout Drive (CM 3790)

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Staff has prepared for council consideration a report concerning a proposed parking prohibition on the north side of Rainbow Trout Drive from Scott Boulevard to a point 200 feet west of Scott Boulevard.

**DISCUSSION:**

At the January 22, 2013 Council meeting, staff was directed to look into creating "No Parking" on the north side of Rainbow Trout from Scott Boulevard to Coho Court. Neighbors along the street would like to see this done in conjunction with the construction of a dental office on the corner of Scott Boulevard and Rainbow Trout Drive.

Currently, there is a median island on Rainbow Trout Drive near Scott Boulevard. Staff has observed traffic congestion issues when vehicles park on the north side of Rainbow Trout Drive, adjacent to the median island. This is primarily due to the width of the lane, where the median is located, not being wide enough to fully accommodate a parked vehicle and larger through moving vehicles. The south lane of Rainbow Trout at the median is wider.

Staff believes that prohibiting parking on the north side of Rainbow Trout, from Scott Boulevard to a point 200 feet west of Scott Boulevard, will address the congestion situation being caused by parked vehicles on the north side. Additional marking on the south side near the stop sign will help inform drivers to not park too close to the stop sign.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Estimated cost is \$550 for materials, equipment, and labor, and will be paid from the Street Maintenance budget.

**SUGGESTED COUNCIL ACTIONS:**

If Council agrees with staff recommendation, direct staff to prepare an ordinance amending Ordinance 14-324 to prohibit parking on the north side of Rainbow Trout Drive from Scott Boulevard to a point 200 feet west of Scott Boulevard.
