Council Bill No. B 184-13

AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to establish a 10-hour parking zone on the north side of Locust Street, between Waugh Street and College Avenue; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-414. Ten-hour zones.

No person shall, during the hours set forth in this division, park a vehicle in any parking space on the following designated streets or off-street parking lots alongside of, next to, in front of, or behind which a ten-hour parking meter is installed, for a longer period of time than ten (10) hours at the rate established in section 14-413:

Alley between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, bordered by Ash Street and Walnut Street.

Locust Street, north side, between ~~one hundred twenty (120) feet west of the west curbline of~~ Waugh Street and College Avenue.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

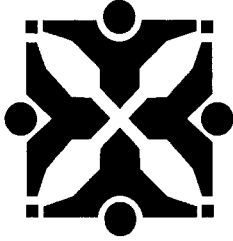

Re: Metering Locust Street between Hitt Street and Waugh Street (CM 3864)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance amending Section 14-414 of the City Code to allow metered parking on the north side of Locust Street between Hitt Street and Waugh Street.

DISCUSSION:

At the June 17, 2013 Council meeting, staff provided a report concerning installing additional parking meters on Locust Street between Hitt and Waugh streets. Staff indicated that a representative of Sacred Heart Church, located at 1115 Locust Street, voiced concerns about possible parking issues once the construction of the nearby apartment building is complete. The block near the church currently has no meters. Staff determined that there was adequate space for ten (10) additional metered parking spaces on the north side of Locust between Hitt Street and Waugh Street. Council directed staff to bring forward an ordinance allowing additional metered parking on Locust Street.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost to purchase, ship and install ten meters (4 duplexes and 2 singles), plus painting of stall lines and curbs is \$3,514, and would be paid from the Parking Utility.
