

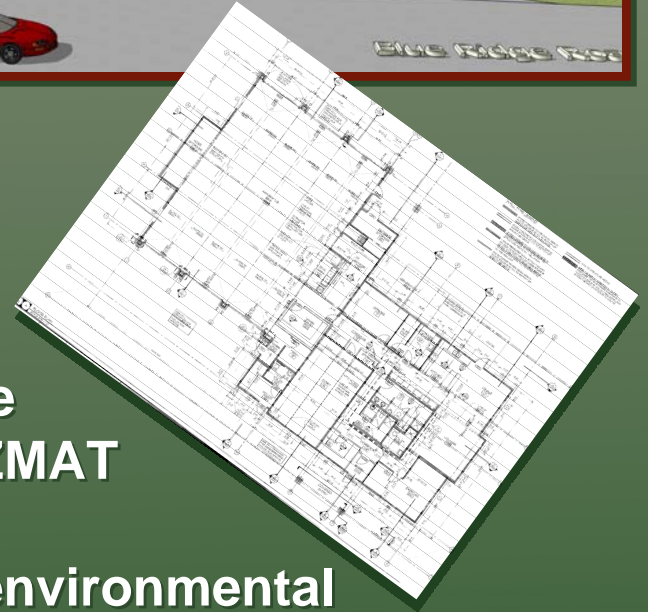
# LEED®ing the way



## Fire Station No. 9

Situated on the Northwest corner of North Providence Road and Blue Ridge Road in Columbia, Fire Station No. 9 will become the HAZMAT station in the City's complement.

Demonstrating a commitment to environmental stewardship and social responsibility, the City has also decided to pursue LEED Certification for this new station. Construction began on the project in April of 2009 and is anticipated to be completed in October of 2009.



### LEED Design Elements:

- Use of FSC certified lumber for the project
- Recycling of construction waste
- Use of low VOC sealants and paints
- Recycled content products for flooring
- Recycled content products for siding
- Recycled brick veneer
- The site will include innovative methods of collecting and cleaning storm water runoff created by the development on the site including a rain garden and bio-swale.
