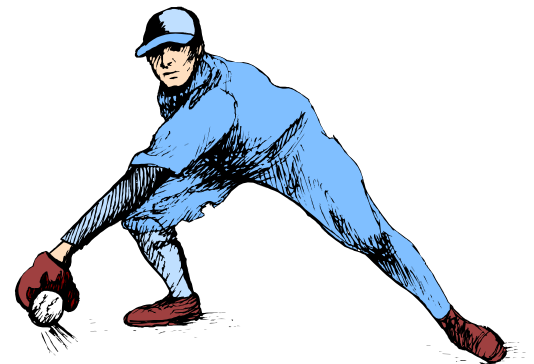
**LEAGUE FEES (same since 2010)**

Slow pitch leagues will be offered Sunday through Friday nights. The total entry fee for each league is based on an Activity Fee and a User Fee and each fee will vary depending on the number of games played. Listed below are the formulas used to calculate softball fees.

User Fee: \$.60/hr. (1 hour game) X 12 player roster = \$7.20/game

Activity Fee: one umpire games = \$34.00 per game/per team

Example: Entry fee based on a 16 game season using one umpire  
\$34.00/game Activity Fee X 16 games = \$544.00  
\$7.20/game User Fee X 16 games = \$115.20  
Total Softball Fee = \$659.20

**AMATEUR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION REGISTRATION**

As a special service, the Columbia Parks and Recreation Department will automatically register all city league teams with the Amateur Softball Association. As an ASA registered team, you will be eligible to participate in all ASA sanctioned tournaments.

**HOME RUN CLASSIFICATION FOR CITY LEAGUE PLAY**

A limit of over-the-fence home runs will be used in all Men's and Co-Rec slow pitch divisions. **ALL balls hit over the fence by a team in excess of the following limitations per game will be ruled as an OUT.**

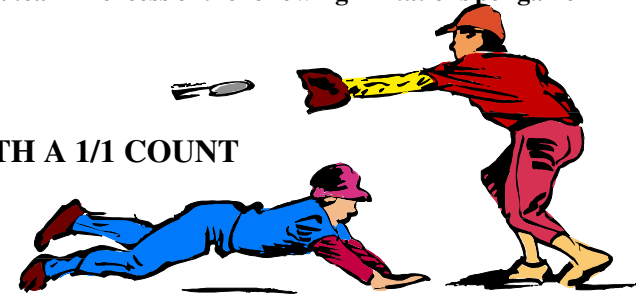
Six (6) home runs per game – Men's Class B

Four (4) home runs per game – Church, Coed C, Men's C, Women's C

Two (2) home runs per game – Coed D, Men's D, Women's D

Zero (0) home runs per game – Coed E, Men's E

**TEAM CLASSIFICATIONS**

In order to promote a standard statewide team classification systems, the Columbia Parks and Recreation Department has adopted the Missouri Amateur Softball Association and the National Softball Association's guidelines for team classifications. Team classifications are designed to differentiate between levels of competition. Teams are encouraged to enter the appropriate classification that will enable them to compete at a reasonable level. If a team enters a level of play that is deemed beneath or above their level of play, the Sports Programming Supervisor reserves the authority to relocate the team at the appropriate level of play. Basic classification definitions are listed below for the Men's, Women's and Co-Rec Divisions.

**ASA CLASS B** – This is the most competitive division in city league play. These teams should be the most skilled teams in the city leagues. These teams are skilled offensively and defensively with players that have good skills, athletic abilities and experience. Defensively, they are capable of taking games away from their opponents with consistent, clean fielding and can turn the double play on the harder to average hit ground ball. Offensively they generally have a good team batting average with one or two players possessing power. Class "B" teams have experience playing together. Teams that competed in Class "B" leagues last year and Class "C" teams that won their league with 2 or fewer losses would qualify for Class "B".

**ASA CLASS C** - These teams generally have average moderately skilled players, but not all defensive and offensive positions will be filled with skilled or experienced players. Offensively, they may or may not have only one player with power. Teams that competed in Class "C" or "D" leagues last year would qualify for this league.

**ASA CLASS D** – These teams generally participate in softball more for its recreational value than for competition. These teams may typically play in one tournament or less during the course of the season.

**ASA CLASS E** – These teams play for the recreational value of playing softball. These teams do not play in any tournaments throughout the course of the season.

**CHURCH** - Church leagues must consist of teams that are comprised of church members only.

**SENIOR** - Senior leagues must consist of teams that are comprised of members fifty (50) years of age or older.



**2012 SUMMER AVAILABLE LEAGUES AND FEES** (Same fees since 2010)

Indicate your league choice on the official entry form. Leagues with fewer than four teams after all registration is completed, will be dropped and teams offered a different league. Number of games listed are guaranteed with the exception of forfeit games. Team limit and game times may be changed to accommodate demand. Leagues may also be combined if there are not enough teams registered to fill a league.

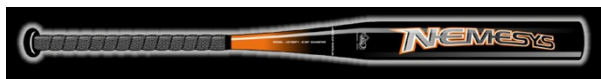
