Description of Proposed Amendment

Attached is a proposed amendment to the CATSO FY 2011-2014 TIP. The request is for the addition of a project to reconstruct the US 63 & Route H intersection, including the relocation of approximately 4.8 miles of the southbound lanes of US 63. A portion of the lane relocation element of the project is within the CATSO planning area, although the intersection itself is not.

Project cost details are included in the TIP budget spreadsheet. The estimated cost is \$15,737,000, with the majority of the \$ budgeted in FY 2011. Tentatively, the project is scheduled to be advertised in April & awarded in June 2011.

After a public hearing, the proposed MRP amendment was formally adopted at the April 12, 2011 CATSO Coordinating Committee meeting.
