

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2010 HOME ACTION PLAN

The City of Columbia will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 15, 2010, in the City Council Chambers of the New City Hall building, 701 East Broadway. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive citizen input on a proposed amendment to the City's Action Plan for FY 2010. The Action Plan was originally approved by HUD on February 10, 2010. The City of Columbia amends its Action Plan whenever it decides not to carry out a project described in the approved Action Plan; to carry out a project not previously approved; or to substantially change the purpose, scope, location or beneficiaries of a project.
