

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FY 2012 ACTION PLAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS

The Community Development Commission (CDC), City of Columbia, will hold a public hearing at 7:00 P.M. on January 12, 2011 in Room 1B of the new City Hall building, 701 E. Broadway. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public suggestions and proposals on the needs and priorities for public infrastructure, community facilities, community services, housing and supportive services for special needs populations, and homeless facilities and services to be included in the City's 2012 Annual Action Plan. Types of activities discussed will include streets, sidewalks, storm drainage, parks and recreational facilities; the construction or renovation of community centers and buildings providing supportive services to various populations, groups or neighborhoods; economic development and job training activities, homeless shelters and transitional housing, supportive services for homeless and special needs populations and other improvement projects. All activities must be eligible for funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development through Community Development Block Grant Funding, HOME funding, or other sources of HUD funding; and will primarily serve low to moderate income persons.
