MID-MO RECYCLING DOES NOT EXPORT MATERIALS OVERSEAS.

Incoming items are sold or de-manufactured. Most items are sold wholesale to local computer stores to be resold. Some items are given to nonprofits (Boys/Girls Club, 4-H, smaller schools/churches). Items are de-manufactured in Columbia with the exception of monitors and TVs which are de-manufactured at D-Cal Services in St. Louis. Metals are sold to Advantage Metals in Columbia. Circuit boards are usually sent to Redlin in Canada. All items are recycled including screws, plastic, paper and cardboard boxes. No computer items are landfilled. **Hard drives can be destroyed at the collection site upon request: \$5 fee if the hard drive is out of the computer; \$10 fee if the hard drive needs to be removed.**

Mid-MO Recycling is a State of Missouri, DNR Level 1 Recycling Center through the Missouri Department of Natural Resources E-waste certification program.
