- I will be asked to provide a record of volunteer hours given to this bed by myself and my group a few times each year. These volunteer hours help the city measure the activities of the program.

- Provide a sign in recognition for your efforts.
- Provide feedback to you on your bed both praise on a "job well done" or ideas for improvement.
- Communicate any comments received on your bed from the public.
- Provide information of assistance to adopters through newsletters, e-mail and educational meetings.

Re: Adopt-A-Spot Beautification Agreements

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Volunteer Programs is submitting for approval four Adopt-A-Spot Beautification agreements to allow volunteers to care for landscaping in street right of way.

#### DISCUSSION:

Volunteers maintain more than 90 landscaped beds in city or state right of way in the City of Columbia. Adopters are responsible for weeding, watering, and mulching the beds and planting annual flowers and bulbs. Agreements are written for a four-year commitment and each bed has a sign to acknowledge the efforts of the adopter.

Staff is submitting four agreements for approval:

- Gary & Linda Shillito will be maintaining bed #3 in the median of Chapel Hill Road west of Scott Boulevard. The Shillito's live nearby and would like to continue the work done in years past by the neighborhood. This is an existing bed with planting areas in both ends.
- Mike Sinn with Good Help Lawn & Garden will be caring for bed #4 in the median of Chapel Hill Road west of Scott Boulevard. This is an existing bed with planting areas in both ends.
- The Hunter's Gate Neighborhood Association has taken over maintenance of the roundabout at Garth Avenue and Blue Ridge Road. This roundabout has existing landscaping the neighborhood will maintain.
- Columbia Appliance has agreed to maintain a median in Wesfall Drive south of Vandiver. This median has been in place for several years but has not been landscaped. Volunteer Programs is working with MU students to give this bed an overhaul on August 17 and will assist with landscaping materials including plants, compost and mulch. Staff is exploring the installation of a water hydrant as well.

The City's Volunteer Programs staff appreciates the investment that volunteers put into Adopt-A-Spot beds to be enjoyed by hundreds of residents and visitors each day.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will assist with ongoing support by providing mulch, bulbs, annual flowers, and replacement plants as needed. The City will pay for a sign to acknowledge the work of each adopter at a cost of \$130 per sign. Labor, which is the largest expense in maintaining the beds, will be provided by adopter.
